**BRIDGE OPERATIONS ARE TO REMAIN THE SAME**

As of today, there is no directive from the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) indicating the mandatory closure of Land Port of Entries along the Southwest border with Mexico. Cameron County is in constant communication with local, state, and federal government entities which include CBP and the Servicio de Administración Tributaria (Mexican Customs/Aduanas) for any updates.

At this time, our international bridge operations are to remain the same and Cameron County continues to handle any and all commercial, passenger vehicles, and pedestrian traffic crossings.

Cameron County International Bridges to remain open are:

- Veterans International Bridge at Los Tomates – Open 6:00 AM to 12 Midnight
- Gateway International Bridge – Open 24 Hours
- Free Trade International Bridge at Los Indios – Open 6:00 AM to 12 Midnight

The safety and well-being of the general public is our primary focus and we will inform of any updates. Cameron County is committed to the connectivity amongst our international border crossings and sister cities and will be taking all precautionary measures as needed.
