FREE TRADE INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE HOURS OF OPERATIONS

In light of the COVID-19 and binational efforts to reduce the immediate threats to life, public health, and safety of all, the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) and Servicio de Administración Tributaria (SAT) in Mexico have modified the Free Trade International Bridge at Los Indios hours of operations for passenger vehicles and pedestrian traffic crossing to 6:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m until further notice. Thus, passenger vehicles and pedestrians both, southbound and northbound will adhere to the same hours of operation, which is 6 am to 4 pm. The hours of operation for Commercial vehicles are to remain the same and will continue to conduct business as usual.

The Cameron County International Bridges such as the Veterans International Bridge at Los Tomates and the Gateway International Bridge are to continue regularly scheduled hours of operations which are:

- Veterans International Bridge at Los Tomates Open 6:00 AM to 12 Midnight
- Gateway International Bridge Open 24 Hours

"In this time of crisis and uncertainty in the world, we have decided to temporarily modify the Free Trade International Bridge hours of operations until further notice" stated Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr. Treviño further stated "this will allow CBP to better utilize their resources, and we ask the public at all times continue to practice social distancing and be mindful of personal hygiene practices which are considered as preventative measures to mitigate our own exposure to COVID-19. In an effort to reduce the spread and exposure of all, please protect yourself, to protect us".
