CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEES TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Today, July 31, 2020, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the Justice of the Peace 5 Office, one (1) employee from the Juvenile Probation Department, two (2) employees from the Adult Probation Department, one (1) employee from Public Works Precinct 1, one (1) employee from Public Works Precinct 3, three (3) employees from the Parks System, seven (7) employees from the Sheriff's Office, and four (4) employees from the Health Department have tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.

The Public Health Department is working closely with elected officials and department heads to continue taking the appropriate steps to keep their employees and the public safe. Constituents are asked to continue to conduct business online by going through the County's website at <https://www.cameroncounty.us/>.

"This week we reported the highest daily numbers of COVID-19 cases for our entire County. We need to understand the severity of this virus and realize that we all have the responsibility to keep each other safe, healthy, and alive. As I have informed over the month, our area hospitals are experiencing overwhelming number of COVID-19 hospitalizations and have not decreased. I continue to ask that you please shelter-in-place, utilize a facial covering, and heed to orders and mandates we have in place. Remember, the life you save may be your own," stated Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr. "Further, to all County employees, please continue to protect yourselves and utilize health and sanitation protocols when out in public to prevent the spread of COVID-19 both at work and at home."
