CLARIFICATION TO: EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

ORDER EXTENDING MANDATORY COUNTYWIDE SHELTER IN PLACE WITH LIFTING OF CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS DATED APRIL 20, 2020

On April 20, 2020, Cameron County Judge issued the Emergency Management Order Extending Mandatory Countywide Shelter in Place with Lifting of Certain Restrictions Order. The Order is effective immediately except for the following two areas:

1. "Retail shopping for pick-up, curbside, or delivery via online shopping or by phone order will be allowed for non-essential businesses but Social Distancing and face masks or coverings by employees and customers will be required. The limitation of gathering of no more than ten customers will continue to be observed."

In compliance and conformance with Governor Abbott's Executive Order GA-16, "starting at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, April 24, 2020, retail services that are not 'essential services,' but that may be provided through pickup, delivery by mail, or delivery to the customer's doorstep in strict compliance with the terms required by DSHS. The DSHS requirements may be found at www.dshs.texas.gov/coronavirus."

2. "Medical and Dental practices may begin to perform elective procedures with Social Distancing in waiting rooms and the use of Face Coverings or Masks. The limitation of gathering of no more than ten patients will continue to be observed."

The County defers the performance of elective medical or dental procedures to the appropriate licensing board(s), such as the Texas State Board of Dental Examiners and the Texas Medical Board, the Office of the Governor, and must adhere to CDC guidelines.
