Two CCJD Employee(s) Presumed Positive for COVID-19

SAN BENITO, TEXAS: The Cameron County Juvenile Justice Department (CCJD) was notified by two (2) employees working at the Amador R. Rodriguez Juvenile Boot Camp & Educational Center that they may be positive for COVID-19. The employees are drill instructors at the juvenile boot camp and immediately sought medical screening after having symptoms related to COVID-19. Because of privacy laws, the department will not release specific details of the employees. CCJD is working closely with the Cameron County Health Department and is awaiting official confirmation, however, treating both cases as presumed positive.

CCJD is committed with ensuring the safety of the juvenile residents and staff. Since the onset of this pandemic, our department has been taking strict precautions against COVID-19 with regards to cleaning of all facilities, social distancing, use of sanitizer and washing of hands, the wearing of facial protection and temperature screenings of all employees at the beginning of every shift. CCJD has been implementing the safety precautions in accordance to the guidelines from the Center Disease Control, County Officials and Medical Health Authority.

CCJD will continue to adhere to the CDC guidelines and provide the quality of care, supervision and safety of the juvenile residents, and employees. The department will keep in close contact with the Cameron County Health Department and Dr. Alberto Almeida, CCJD’s Medical Health Authority in monitoring matters.
