**CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEES TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19**

Today, August 21, 2020, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the County Clerk's Office, one (1) employee from the District Clerk's Office, two (2) employees from the Public Health Department, and three (3) employees from the Sheriff's Office have tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.

The Public Health Department is working closely with elected officials and department heads to continue taking the appropriate steps to keep their employees and the public safe. "Although we are reporting a few employees with COVID-19 this week, we need to continue to do our part and remain and keep others safe.
