CAMERON COUNTY TO OPEN TWO COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINICS

Cameron County will host two COVID-19 vaccination clinics this week, Wednesday, January 13, 2021 at the Los Fresnos Fire Department located at 100 Rodeo Dr. in Los Fresnos and Friday, January 15, 2021 at the Brownsville Sports Park located at 1100 Sports Park Blvd. in Brownsville. The Moderna vaccine will be administered to 2,350 individuals at each location who are 65 years of age and older or individuals 18 years of age and older with underlying health conditions. Frontline healthcare workers who have not received the vaccine will also be eligible to receive the vaccine.

Cameron County Public Health received 6,000 vaccines on Friday, January 8, 2021 of which 1,000 were administered in addition to the already allocated 1,000 doses at the COVID-19 vaccination clinic held at Casa del Sol in Harlingen. The remaining doses will be administered for individuals within the Phase 1A and 1B priority groups.

As a reminder, Phase 1B guidelines include persons who are 65 years of age or older, and persons 18 years of age or older with at least one chronic medical health condition below:

- Cancer,
- Chronic Kidney Disease,
- COPD (Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease),
- Heart Conditions, such as heart failure, coronary artery disease or cardiomyopathies,
- Solid Organ Transplant,
- Obesity and severe obesity (body mass index of 30 kg/m² or higher),
- Pregnancy,
- Sickle cell disease or
- Type 2 diabetes mellitus.

Cameron County Public Health has partnered with the Los Fresnos Independent School District and Brownsville Independent School District to administer the vaccines. The vaccinations will be available on a first come, first served basis from 6:00 a.m. through 6:00 p.m. or until supplies last. The public is asked to please remain in your vehicle upon arrival and complete the consent and registration form ahead of time. These forms can be found at www.cameroncounty.us/publichealth/index.php/coronavirus/. Forms will also be provided onsite. No drop-offs or walk-ins will be allowed.
