**CAMERON COUNTY TO HOLD SECOND-DOSE COVID-19
MASS VACCINATION CLINIC THIS FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 2021**

Cameron County will host a second-dose COVID-19 mass vaccination clinic on Friday, February 26, 2021, at the Los Fresnos Fire Department located at 100 Rodeo Dr. for those individuals that were vaccinated at the same location on Friday, January 29, 2021.

Individuals will be vaccinated with the second dose of the Moderna Vaccine and are asked to please arrive between 6:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m., with your ID, COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card, and remain in your vehicle upon arrival. For the health and safety of all individuals, there is no need to arrive or camp out overnight as vaccines are available and reserved for this vaccination clinic.

Cameron County Public Health continues to work with different cities throughout the County for vaccination allocation efforts and this week allocated a limited number of Moderna Vaccines to: Brownsville, Harlingen, Primera, Port Isabel, and Santa Rosa. All individuals are asked to please contact or visit the website of your local municipality for vaccine availability and registration information.

Cameron County Public Health is committed to administering the vaccines in accordance with the guidance from the State of Texas and the CDC. Cameron County has partnered with Los Fresnos ISD, TSTC, and the UTHealth School of Public Health for continued vaccination allocation and administration efforts and will provide additional first and second dose vaccination clinic updates as allocations are confirmed.
