



3ND UPDATED ORDER FOR REMOTE PARTICIPATION IN COURT PROCEEDINGS VIA VIDEO CONFERENCING

To schedule and hold court proceedings on all matters;

To avoid risk to court staff, parties, witnesses, attorneys, jurors and the public;

To safely provide timely access to justice;

To avoid case backlogs and unnecessary delays;

In compliance with state, county, and local directives; and

Pursuant to the authority of the Texas Supreme Court's *Thirty-Sixth Emergency Order Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster* (Misc. Docket No. 21-9026), which directs Texas courts **to continue the use reasonable efforts to conduct proceedings remotely**, Cameron County Court at Law No. 4 hereby ORDERS:

All persons, including parties, attorneys, witnesses, court staff, court reporters, and jurors involved in hearings, depositions, mediations, trials or court proceedings of any kind in Cameron County Court at Law No. 4, **shall** participate remotely by videoconference.

The Clerk shall file this Order in each case listed above.
