This raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 40,296 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 72 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 37,311.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of fourteen (14) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. These reports follow updates from the Texas Department of State Health Services and city vital statistics data, which included reports of individuals who died outside of Cameron County and dating back to June 2020. This raises the total number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,627.
