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(i) The meeting was called to order by Chairman De Leon at 2:03 p.m. and the Commission considered the following matters as posted and filed for record in the Office of the County Clerk on December 10, 2018.

**(1) PUBLIC COMMENTS**

**(1A) CIVIL SERVICE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Gilberto Elizondo, Jr., Civil Service Director, informed the Commission of one pending appeal, docket entry #18-97-10-512. Docket entry #18-98-10-551 and docket entry #18-99-10-555 have been administratively dismissed since the last meeting of the Civil Service Commission on September 13, 2018.

**(2A) CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR THE PREVIOUS SPECIAL MEETING**

Chairman De Leon asked if there is a motion to approve the minutes for the meeting held on September 13, 2018. Anthony Lopez, Civil Service Coordinator, stated the minutes were not ready and would be provided for consideration at the next meeting of the Civil Service Commission. Chairman De Leon motioned to table the item and was seconded by Commissioners Alegria. Chairmen De Leon asked for a vote and all voted "AYE". Therefore, the minutes for Special Meeting for September 13, 2018, were tabled.

**(2B) ACTION ON THE APPEAL OF REYNALDO SAENZ #18-97-10-512**

Gilberto Elizondo, Jr., Civil Service Director, informed the Commission that Reynaldo Saenz's appeal has been pending since April 2018. Anthony Lopez, Civil Service Coordinator, informed the Commission the attorney for Reynaldo Saenz, J.R. Ramirez, provided a statement in writing that no contact has been had with Reynaldo Saenz since the appeal was made. Chairman De Leon asked for a motion and Commissioner and Commissioner Uhles moved to approve the recommendation of the Civil Service Director and dismiss the appeal of Reynaldo Saenz #18-97-10-512 for want of interest. Commissioner Alegria seconded the motion and Chairman De Leon asked for a vote; all voted "AYE" and the motion carried.

**(2C) ACTION ON THE ATTEMPTED APPEAL OF JAVIER VIVERO #18-98-10-551**

Cameron County Attorney Daniel Lopez appeared on behalf of the Constable Precinct #1 and Attorney David Willis appeared on behalf of Javier Vivero. Both attorneys presented their evidence and testimony and after all was presented to the Civil Service Commission, the Commission went into executive session at 2:27 p.m. and gaveled back into open session at 2:47 p.m. Chairman De Leon asked for a motion and Commissioner Uhles moved that the Civil Service Commission did not have jurisdiction to hear the appeal.

Commissioner Alegria seconded the motion and Chairman De Leon asked for a vote; all voted "AYE" and the motion carried.

**(2D) ACTION ON THE ATTEMPTED APPEAL OF JOSHUA GOMEZ #18-99-10-555**

Cameron County Attorney Daniel Lopez appeared on behalf of the Constable Precinct #5 and Attorney David Willis appeared on behalf of Joshua Gomez. Both attorneys presented their evidence and testimony and after all was presented to the Civil Service Commission, the Commission went into executive session at 3:23 p.m. and gaveled back into open session at 3:42 p.m. Chairman De Leon asked for a motion and Commissioner Uhles moved that the Civil Service Commission did have jurisdiction to hear the appeal. Commissioner Alegria seconded the motion and Chairman De Leon asked for a vote; all voted "AYE" and the motion carried. With no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 3:43 p.m.


