INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into between the COUNTY OF CAMERON, TEXAS, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and the CITY OF PALM VALLEY, hereinafter referred to as "CITY" pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code, Chapter 791, cited as the Interlocal Cooperation Act.

WHEREAS, Cameron County is a county in the State of Texas;

WHEREAS, the City of Palm Valley is a general municipality located in Cameron County, Texas;

WHEREAS, City and County, each pursuant to its statutory and constitutional authority, are responsible for maintenance and improvements of certain public roadways within their respective borders;

WHEREAS, City and County desire to provide and perform road improvements "seal coat" to streets located in the City;

WHEREAS, County has determined that the County will receive a benefit from the proposed improvements to approximately 6.8 miles of city streets, that such will serve a county purpose, and that Texas Transportation Code 251.012 permits the expenditure of County funds for such purpose;

WHEREAS, County and City are authorized to enter into this Agreement pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code 791.001 et seq., Section 791032 as well as under the terms of Texas Transportation code 251.012;


WHEREAS, City, pursuant to Texas Transportation Code 251.012, requests and authorizes the County to perform the work and services described herein within its corporate city limits and to be partially funded by the County.

1. LOCATION OF PROJECT: City of Palm Valley, Cameron County, Texas.
2. WORK AND SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED: Approximately 6.8 miles or 135,028 square yards of material to "seal coat" city streets.
3. City will be responsible for the materials for the project, with the County providing the labor and equipment. The improvements shall be done in accordance to attached plans and/or specifications, and cost estimates.
4. The execution and performance of this Agreement by County and City have been duly authorized by all necessary laws, resolutions, or corporate action, and this Agreement constitutes the valid and enforceable obligations of County and City in accordance with its terms.
5. This Agreement constitutes a one-time agreement between the parties and does not constitute a continuing agreement or responsibility for maintenance of any city street in the City. Any future maintenance for said streets will be the responsibility of the City.
6. Each party agrees to conform to its own applicable laws, regulations, policies, and procedures with respect to the performance of the work and services under this Agreement. The Agreement shall


have no legal force or effect until such time as it is properly adopted and approved by the CAMERON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT and the CITY OF PALM VALLEY COUNCIL. This agreement shall terminate on completion of the project.

7. The parties agree that the County will be released of any and all duties imposed by this Agreement following completion of the work and service described in this Agreement.
8. All expenditures made under this Agreement will be made from the current revenues of the paying party and under the authority of Texas Transportation Code 251.012.


