PAYMENT OF FINES AND COURT COST

A **FINE** IS PART OF THE PUNISHMENT FOR THE CRIME COMMITTED. **COURT COSTS** ARE PART OF THE EXPENSE OF LEGALLY PROCESSING YOUR CASE. FAILURE TO PAY EITHER CAN RESULT IN YOUR ARREST AND CONFINEMENT AS WELL AS BEING CONSIDERED A VIOLATION OF YOUR CONDITIONS OF PROBATION. A WARRANT FOR YOUR ARREST MAY BE ISSUED FOR FAILURE TO PAY YOUR FINE AND COURT COST AND YOU COULD BE HELD IN THE CAMERON COUNTY JAIL WITHOUT BOND UNLESS THE JUDGE ORDERS OTHER WISE.

GENERAL PROCESSING

APPLICATION

You **must** complete an application. An incomplete application will delay your processing time. The references on your application **will be verified and must answer** in order to be granted a payment plan.

INTERVIEW

You **must** be interviewed. During the interview, terms for payment will be established. Maximum terms usually do not exceed 90 (ninety) days.

PROCESSING TIME

Your application will be processed in the order in which it was received. Your name will be called for interviewing as soon as possible. Your patience is appreciated.

QUESTIONS

All of your questions about the payment of your fines and court cost should be answered before you leave. The time to clear up any questions is during the interview.
